I am requesting funding for the Portside Intermodal Cargo Project in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Port of Port Arthur, located at 221 Houston Avenue (P.O. Box 1428) Port Arthur, Texas 77640. The funding would be used for the design and construction of a 6.5-acre waterside laydown yard with road, rail, and maritime access supporting U.S. exports and U.S. manufacturing. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it enhances connectivity between road, rail, and maritime, while it supports American exports and manufacturing, the U.S. military, and local job creation.
