I am requesting funding for the improvement of rail reverse curves from South Childers to Alabama Street in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is Orange County Navigation and Port District (Port of Orange), located at 1201 S. Childers Road, Orange, Texas 77630. The funding would be used to improve the rail reverse curves from a tight 19-degree to an 11-degree curve to activate the rail service.
