I am requesting funding for Scholes International Airport, Airport Improvement Program (AIP) – Part 139 Certification Airfield Improvements and New General Aviation (GA) Terminal in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is Scholes International Airport, located at 2115 Terminal Drive Galveston, Texas 77554. The funding would be used for Scholes International Airport airfield improvements to meet U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT) Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Title 14, CFR Part 139 Certification commercial air service operations requirements and new general aviation terminal construction. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because a forecasted increase in tourism and flight demand will result in efforts necessary to sustain strong airport operations for years to come.

This project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by AIP eligible in accordance with 49 U.S.C. 47100 et seq., and FAA policy and guidance and is included in the FAA's National Plan of Integrated Airport Systems (NPIAS).
