Dear Chairman Womack and Ranking Member Quigley:

I am requesting funding for the City of West Columbia Phase 1 street reconstruction in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of West Columbia, located at 512 E. Brazos Avenue, West Columbia, Texas 77486. The funding would be used to reconstruct 2.4 miles of two-lane asphalt residential streets and collectors in the city due to severe pavement distresses associated with roadways at the end of their life cycles. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because providing new pavement and resetting the life cycle of the 6.5 miles of poor-condition roads will mitigate over \$1 million in vehicle operating benefits alone throughout the pavement life cycle.

This project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Community Development Fund (CDF) 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2).
